- Original Passport. (6 months of validity with minimum 2 blank pages)
- Photo with white background plus size of (45\*35).
- 6 months bank statement with 2 lakhs above closing balance. (only for first time traveller to China)
- Visa application form(including father, mother, child, spouse name and date of birth, passport holder's phone number, email, current residence).
- 5.working- 6 to 8 working days.
