Bali Tourist Visa FAQs for Nepali Citizens

Do Nepali citizens need a visa to visit Bali?

Yes. Nepali passport holders must apply for a **B211A Tourist Visa** before traveling to Bali. This visa is valid for **60 days** and can be extended **twice**, each time for another 60 days—allowing a **maximum stay of 180 days**.

When should I apply for the visa?

It's best to apply 3–4 weeks before your travel date to allow enough time for processing.

Can I work or earn money in Bali with this visa?

No. The B211A visa is strictly for **tourism, social visits, or sourcing**. Working or earning income in Indonesia is **not permitted** under this visa.

Can I extend my visa while in Bali?

Yes. You can extend the B211A visa twice, each for 60 days, by visiting the local immigration office in Bali.
