Itinerary

Day 1: Arrival at Prague

Welcome to Prague -Capital of the Czech Republic ,on arrival meet your driver and proceed to Hotel , check in to Hotel ,evening Free at leisure ,Over Night at hotel in Prague .

Day 2: Best of Prague with Castle, lunch with 1 drink and one hour long cruise with coffee and cake

Breakfast at Hotel later proceed to Best of Prague with Castle, lunch with 1 drink and one hour long cruise with coffee and cake , See the most of Prague by bus, boat and walking tour. See the most of Prague during a six and a half hour bus, boat and walking tour. We begin at the Wenceslas Square where we board on an air-conditioned bus with tour guide and drive around the most significant places in Prague (such as the National Museum and the Dancing House), eventually reaching the dominant of the city, the Prague Castle. From there, we will continue on foot down to the Lesser Town, Kampa Island, Charles Bridge, Old Town with the Astronomical Clock and the Jewish Quarter. Finally, we will enjoy the view of Hradcany, the National Theatre and other Prague gems during a boat cruise through the Vltava river. This tour ends at the Dvorak Riverside in the vicinity of the Cech Bridge. evening Back to hotel , Over night at Prague hotel

Day 3: Prague to Vienna by Train



Breakfast at hotel ,later check out and Proceed to Train station - Board Train to Vienna ,Reach hotel Check in to Hotel ,Evening Free at leisure , Over night at hotel in Vienna

Day 4: Vienna City Tour and Schonbrunn Palace

Breakfast at Hotel later Take a tour of the main sights within the city centre and visit the magnificently decorated rooms of Schonbrunn Palace. This city tour will introduce you to the the most important sights of the Austrian capital. As we drive around the famous 'Ringstrasse', Vienna's main boulevard, we pass by the State Opera, the Museums of Fine Art and Natural History, the Parliament building, the Burgtheater (National Theatre), the City Hall and the University. The highlight of this programme is the visit to Schonbrunn Palace where we take a tour of some of the most magnificently decorated rooms. We return to the city centre, passing by Belvedere Palace, where you will have the opportunity to end your tour, or you can choose to continue to the State Opera House, where the tour ends.eveing Free at leiusre , Over night at hotel in Vienna

Day 5: Vienna to Budapest by Train

Breakfast at hotel, later you have Free time till afternoon , later proceed to Train station board Train to budapest , on Arrival at Budapest reach hotel by your own , Check in to hotel , evening free at leisure Over night at hotel in Vienna

Day 6: Budapest Grand City Tour and Parliament

After breakfast at the hotel, explore Budapest, one of Europe's most beautiful cities. Stroll through Buda's Castle District, visit Matthias Church and the Fisherman's Bastion for panoramic views. Cross the Elisabeth Bridge to Pest, passing Central Market Hall, Dohány Street Synagogue, City Park, Heroes' Square, Grand Opera House, and St. Stephen's Basilica. End the day with a guided tour of Hungary's Parliament Building, including the Great Hall and Hungarian Crown Jewels. Capture stunning views of the Danube and historic landmarks throughout the city.

(Letter must contain family name & relationship, a copy of covering letter mentioning travel plan with self introduction)

Relation Certificate and Marriage Certificate (Both Required)

Proof of Occupation

Self Employed – Cover letter on company letter head, company registration, partnership, proof of paid tax.

Employed – Work contract, letter from employer (no-objection) confirming leave period & returning back to work, copy of staff id.

Student – Letter from school / College confirming your studies, holiday or leave given to you, copy of Student ID.

Retired – Proof of Retirement / Pension book.

Evidence of Financial Status

Student & Unemployed: Last 6 months Bank Statement of parents or legal guardian.

Retired: Personal pension bank statement for last 6 months. Proof of regular income generated by ownership of property or business & Property Valuation.

Visa & Entry Requirements

Do Nepali citizens need a visa for Europe?

Yes. You'll need a Schengen Visa to visit most European countries.

Which countries are covered by the Schengen Visa?

26 countries including France, Germany, Italy, Spain, Switzerland, and more.

Where do I apply for the visa?

Through VFS Global (Thamel, Kathmandu). Choose the embassy of the country you'll spend the most time in.

How long does visa processing take?

Typically 3–9 working days, but apply at least 1 month in advance

Flights & Travel Tips

Which airlines fly from Nepal to Europe?

Qatar Airways, Turkish Airlines, Emirates, and others via Middle Eastern hubs.

Can I travel between countries freely?

Yes, once inside the Schengen Area, you can move between member countries without border checks.

Can I extend my tourist visa while in Europe?

No, tourist visas cannot be extended while traveling.

What currency is used?

Most countries use the Euro (€), but some (like Switzerland) use their own.

What should I pack?

Warm clothes (Europe can be chilly even in spring)



Power adapter (Europe uses Type C/E/F plugs)

Travel documents + copies

Snacks and Nepali essentials (masala, wai-wai if you miss home!)

Is travel insurance mandatory?

Yes, and it must cover medical emergencies up to €30,000

Do people speak English?

Yes, especially in tourist areas. But learning basic phrases in French, German, or Italian can be helpful.

Are Nepali foods available?

In major cities like London, Paris, and Berlin, yes! You'll find Nepali restaurants and South Asian groceries.
